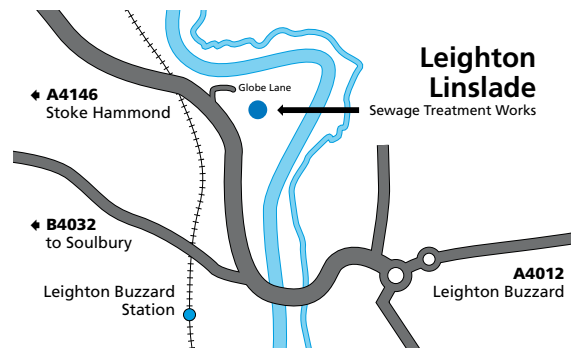

The Anglian Water Education Centre at Leighton Linslade Sewage Treatment Works is off the A4146 near Leighton Buzzard. Turn at the Globe Inn sign and follow signs along the canal to the Centre.

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Located next to the Grand Union Canal and near Stockgrove County Park, the education centre is based at Anglian Water's Sewage Treatment Works at Leighton Linlade.

Each day the works treats wastewater from nearly 35,000 homes and 211 businesses in the Leighton Buzzard area before returning the effluent safely to the River Ouzel.

The Linlade Centre provide an exciting range of opportunities for students in primary, lower, middle, secondary and higher education to study all aspects of the water curriculum, from the natural water cycle to the wastewater treatment processes and recycling.

Facilities at Leighton Linlade

The majority of activities are based around a site tour of the sewage treatment works, but we are always developing new activities. Students will also have access to:

- Field study equipment
- Digital microscope
- Wildlife area
- Training via an interactive white board
